Greetings to all and welcome to the last Newsletter of 2017! It has been an **incredible** semester filled with a wide range of activities such as Phonics, Numeracy, Yoga, Music and Movement, Art&Craft as well as classes in the Computer Lab. Since the beginning of semester up until now, I can see that each child has truly **improved** in all activities and classes. Well done!

This semester, the N2 class was introduced to **phonics**. There are many **benefits** to learning the sound that a word makes, including for pronunciation purposes. So far we have worked our way through the first two groups or phases and have just begun with the third group, which is steady progress. We will continue with the third group, and the remaining groups, next semester. We focused on tracing the lowercase letters of the alphabet and, naturally, singing several alphabet songs! Each day, we also **devote** some time to tracing names and I plan on moving on to more advanced name tracing and writing activities in the next semester.

In **numeracy** we started off with a revision of numbers 1 – 10, and then moved on to the 'teen' numbers. We have worked our way thoroughly through each number, to ensure that each student truly grasps the concept before moving on. In class we make use of a variety of different number recognition activities to make learning numbers fun!

We have had a several **interesting inquiries** this semester, ranging from topics such as heritage, ocean animals, community helpers, famous places around the world until most recently about the seasons and art. Inquiry is an **enjoyable** time for all the students and a great opportunity to **discover** more about things that are of interest to them. We learn as much about each topic as we can, and **incorporate** it into an Art & Craft activity. Dramatic play can also be useful in **exploring** more about the inquiry – which everyone loves!
