Dear K1 Parents,

September has been a **productive** and **activity-filled** month for the K1 students. With our first **Inquiry** of the Academic year well under way, the children have thoroughly enjoyed **exploring** the meaning of **Metamorphosis** (Life cycle) and the interesting animals and insects that go through it! The children were treated to a number of books on the subject brought to school by the **enthusiastic** learners themselves. The students completed two **Art and Craft** projects connected to their **Inquiry** where they were able to explore a number of different **art mediums**.

In **Numeracy**, the children started the month off by revising the **foundation** of every mathematical concept, **counting**. Once they had a clear **understanding** of this they were introduced to **Addition** and **Subtraction**. I am happy to report that the K1 class are making **steady strides** in both concepts. With the help of a number of different **counting aids** such as using their fingers, drawing pictures and pebbles, the children have found that **mathematics** is a fun activity.

During our **Phonics** and **Literacy** class, the K1 students have put a lot of time into **learning** the difference between the uppercase and lowercase alphabet. The children are starting to **understand** that there is a reason some letters are uppercase in words, such as the first letter in their name. In **spelling**, the children completed their first round of spelling words and have started their second. The **concept** of a **spelling test** is still new to the children and I am proud of the **enthusiasm** they show towards it and the **progress** they have made thus far. Thank you for your **assistance** in helping your child study at home!

Welcome to the September Newsletter for the Nursery 2 class! We have had a busy semester thus far, with our usual activities ranging from Numeracy and Phonics to ECA's like Art and Craft, Yoga, Computer and Swimming.

We have continued with the introduction to **Phonics** through learning the sound a different letter makes. We have learnt /s/, /a/, /t/, /i/ and /p/ at this stage. Each sound has a catchy song and hand action that goes along with it. The activities for each sound has been added in each child's **Sound Book**.

The progress with **Numeracy** is going well, with the students learning up to number 15 thus far. We make use of various games to improve the student's recognition of a number. Often, these games also help to improve **concentration** and even fine motor skills.

This month we launched an **Inquiry** on Community Helpers and started off with firefighters. Some time was spent on learning about Fire Safety and about not touching objects which are hot. We have a couple of aspiring firefighters in class! **Dramatic Play** has been especially fun with this Inquiry, as the children would often play out a scene. The **importance** of Dramatic play should not be underestimated, as it is beneficial for language development and social interaction, amongst others. We are in the process of setting up a corner in the classroom dedicated to Dramatic Play.

We have completed a few Art activities, like making Firefighter helmets. Currently, we have a super secret art project underway, centered on our Inquiry on **Community Helpers**.
