Note from Junior School Deputy Principal

Dear Parents and Friends,

It's been a rainy and sunny September.

This month, I will like to share about and bring your attention to the common sicknesses in pre-schools. The viruses responsible for colds or the flu cause the most common sicknesses in child care facilities and schools. Below are some measures to keep these colds/flu at bay:

- **Stay home when you are sick.** If possible, stay home from work, school, and errands when you are sick. You will help prevent others from catching your illness. Avoid close contact with people who are sick. For student's who have caught any infectious diseases, parents' need to obtain a clearance letter from the doctor before your child can return to school.
- **Cover your nose and mouth** with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue away after use and wash your hands. If a tissue is not available, cover your mouth and nose with your sleeve, not your hand.
- **Wash your hands often with soap and water**, especially after you cough or sneeze.
- **Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth.** Germs spread this way.
- **Clean and disinfect surfaces or objects.** Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces at home, work or school, especially when someone is ill.

Our students' health and well-being are our utmost priority. In school, we constantly advise and teach our students good habits such as washing their hands before and after eating. Our classroom and furniture are thoroughly cleaned and sanitized daily.
